Thursday, June 10

Meet new friends on our overnight flight bound for **Dublin, Ireland!**

Friday, June 11

Arrive in Dublin this morning and meet our **Irish driver/guide**, who will take us on a tour of **Dublin City**, Ireland's capital city. We will see the **Georgian Squares** with their 18th Century houses, **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, **Phoenix Park** (the biggest town park in Europe), statue-filled **O'Connell Street** and fashionable **Grafton Street**. No visit to Dublin would be complete without a visit to the **Guinness Brewery**, founded in 1759. After a **self-guided tour**, we will be treated to a pint of Guinness in the 360-degree rooftop bar with its spectacular views. This afternoon we check into the centrally-located, 4-star **Trinity City Hotel** for two nights. The evening is free for you to explore on your own. Our boutique hotel is a short walk from many of Dublin's highlights including Trinity College, the shops of pedestrian-friendly Grafton Street, museums, public squares, whiskey tasting venues, and the vibrant Temple Bar neighborhood.

Saturday, June 12 (Breakfast, Dinner)

This morning we travel to **Glendalough** (Valley of Two Lakes) in **County Wicklow**. This early Christian ecclesiastical settlement was founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Enter the gateway arches that lead into the Cashel where we will find the often-photographed **Round Tower**, the remains of several churches, cathedrals, ancient gravestones and Celtic crosses. Nestled in the foothills of the Wicklow Mountains, **Powerscourt House and Gardens** is an elegant 18th-century Palladian mansion and one of Ireland's most breathtaking estates. We'll **explore its acclaimed gardens** with sweeping terraces, statues and fountains, Italian and Japanese gardens, and rare trees that all create a stunning landscape. This evening we will regroup with your fellow travelers and enjoy dinner in our hotel.

Sunday, June 13 (Breakfast, Dinner)

This morning enjoy a full Irish breakfast before we journey to **County Kildare**, the center of Ireland's horse breeding industry. Here we will have a guided tour of the **Irish National Stud Farm**, an integral part of the Irish thoroughbred industry for over 100 years. Our next stop is the charming town of **Kilkenny**, where we will have time to enjoy lunch, shop at the **Kilkenny Design Center**, and walk the beautiful and extensive park grounds of **Kilkenny Castle**. Then we're on our way to **Waterford** to meet an **Irish guide** for a **walking tour** of this historic, waterside city. Afterwards we will check into the 4-star **Tower Hotel** for one night. Our hotel's central, waterfront location makes it perfect for exploring the town's rich history and culture.

Monday, June 14 (Breakfast)

Our day starts with a guided tour of the **House of Waterford Crystal**, where we will see highly skilled craftsmen demonstrate crystal blowing and cutting in a new state of the art visitor center. After time to browse the crystal showroom, we travel along the scenic southern coastline. We'll stop for lunch along the way before arriving in **Blarney**. Here we will have an opportunity to visit **Blarney Castle** and kiss the famous **Blarney Stone**, said to bestow the gift of eloquence on all those who dare. We will also have time to visit the **Blarney Woollen Mills** which carries a wide range of sweaters, tweeds, china, and crystal. On our arrival in **Killarney**, we'll check into **Killarney Plaza Hotel & Spa** for three nights. Here you can really enjoy Ireland's most charming and delightful small town. Our posh, 4-star hotel is located in the heart of Killarney with hundreds of shops and pubs that are easily accessible.





Tuesday, June 15 (Breakfast)

Today, we embark on one of Ireland's most famous coastal drives – **The Ring of Kerry**. Our first stop this morning will be at **Kerry Bog Village** where we can visit little thatched cottages and see how people lived in Ireland many years ago. Our tour continues through the wild and rugged landscape of the **Iveragh Peninsula** that offers breathtaking views of the Atlantic coastline. We will enjoy a **sheepdog demonstration** and witness how amazingly intelligent these dogs are as they obey every nuance of their master's commands. We will soon understand why these dogs are so vital to sheep farmers. Pass through the charming towns of **Killorglin, Glenbeigh, Cahirciveen, and Waterville to Sneem**. Our tour then winds its way through the mountains taking in some fine views of the **Lakes of Killarney** and the **Ladies View**.

Available Evening Option: Kate Kearney's Cottage (\$80 per person). Savor a traditional Irish dinner in a warm, welcoming setting, brought to life by lively folk music and dance - a cherished and award-winning cultural experience.



Wednesday, June 16 (Breakfast)

Today, we explore the **Dingle Peninsula**, one of Ireland's most spectacular coastal regions, famed for its rugged cliffs, sandy beaches, and winding country roads that unveil breathtaking vistas at every turn. We will stop at the **Brian de Staic studio in Dingle** which specializes in Celtic jewelry, handcrafted and engraved with ancient Celtic symbols and the letters of the ogham alphabet, an ancient Irish form of writing. As we continue around **Slea Head**, we will have breathtaking views of the Atlantic coastline and see beehive huts (early monastic settlements) dating back over a thousand years. Our tour will take us to the **most westerly point of Ireland** where we can view the **Blasket Islands**. We will also see the locations for such films as *Ryan's Daughter*, *Far and Away* which starred Tom Cruise and Nicole Kidman, and *Star Wars: The Last Jedi*. We will have free time in Dingle for lunch before returning to Killarney. The remainder of the evening is free to enjoy Killarney at our leisure. You may choose to have dinner in one of its many restaurants or simply wander its bustling streets and let the sound of Irish music draw you into one of the town's lively pubs.

Thursday, June 17 (Breakfast, Dinner)

This morning, we will travel in a traditional **Irish Jaunting Car** to **Killarney National Park**. Our journey winds through some of the oldest oak forests in Ireland and by the famous **Lakes of Killarney to Muckross House and Gardens**. Here we will have the option of **exploring this Victorian Mansion**, built in 1843 and one of Ireland's leading stately homes, or taking part in a **scone-making demonstration** and enjoying these treats with homemade jam, fresh cream, and coffee or tea. We then bid farewell to Killarney and travel to **Adare** to see its stone buildings, thatched cottages, medieval monasteries, a charming park, and arts and crafts shops. Following free time in Adare for lunch, we travel to the luxurious 5-star **Dromoland Castle** for an overnight stay. The castle, built in the 16th century, was once the royal seat of the O'Brien clan. Refurbished and transformed into a luxury hotel in 1962, it retains priceless reminders of the castle's historic past. Splendid woodcarvings, stone statuary, and fine antique furnishings surround you during your stay. This evening we will enjoy an incredible **private dinner** in the elegant surroundings of the castle's Terrace Room.

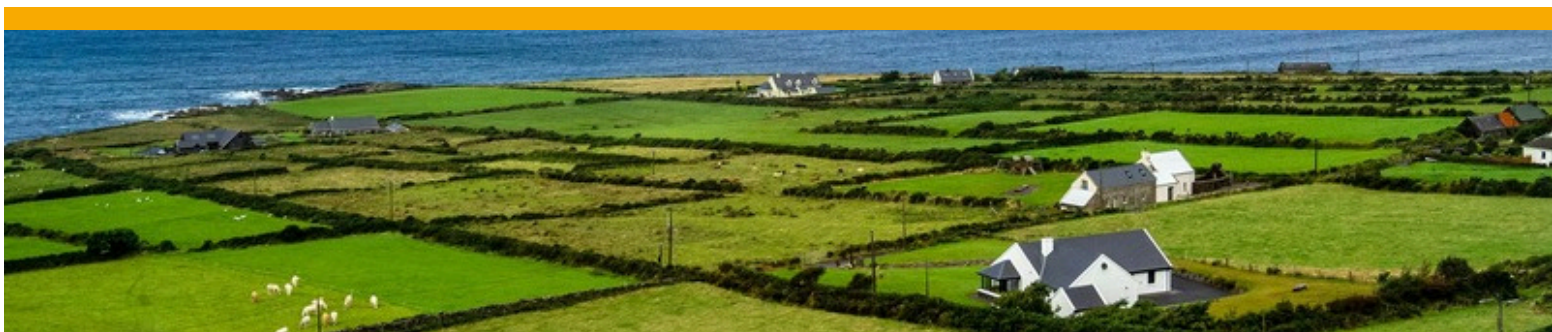


Friday, June 18, 2027 (Breakfast, Dinner)

This morning we depart Dromoland Castle and journey to **Ennis** before heading to the majestic **Cliffs of Moher**, which rise to a height of 600 ft. over the Atlantic Ocean. After free time to explore the cliffs on our own, we wind our way through the **Burren** with its lunar-type landscape. We then continue along the shores of **Galway Bay** before travelling across the Irish midland to the luxurious, 4-star **Castlenock Hotel** for one night. We'll have time to relax and refresh before enjoying a farewell dinner in our hotel's restaurant.

Saturday, June 19, 2027 (Breakfast)

This morning we'll travel to the Dublin Airport for our flight home. We'll be taking fond Irish memories, newly acquired accents, and many stories to relate to friends and family!
